

Announcement on the Measures for People and Vehicles to Exit Hengqin Island Through the “Second-line” of the Guangdong-Macao In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin

Announcement on the Measures for People and Vehicles to Exit Hengqin Island Through the “Second-line” of the Guangdong-Macao In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin

In compliance with the requirements in the Master Plan for the Construction of Guangdong Macao In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin and the Announcement on the Function of Transportation Channels in the “Second-line” of the Guangdong-Macao In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin, it is hereby notified that measures for people and vehicles to leave Hengqin island will be implemented as follows.

1. The Hengqin Bridge

Except for freight vehicles (including construction vehicles), all vehicles and pedestrians can leave Hengqin island through the Hengqin Bridge.

Opening hours: all day

(1) Small Passenger Vehicles

Small passenger vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Huandao East Road or Qinhai East Road. Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave Hengqin island directly, while selected vehicles shall go to the vehicle inspection area as instructed and undergo customs inspection before leaving the island.

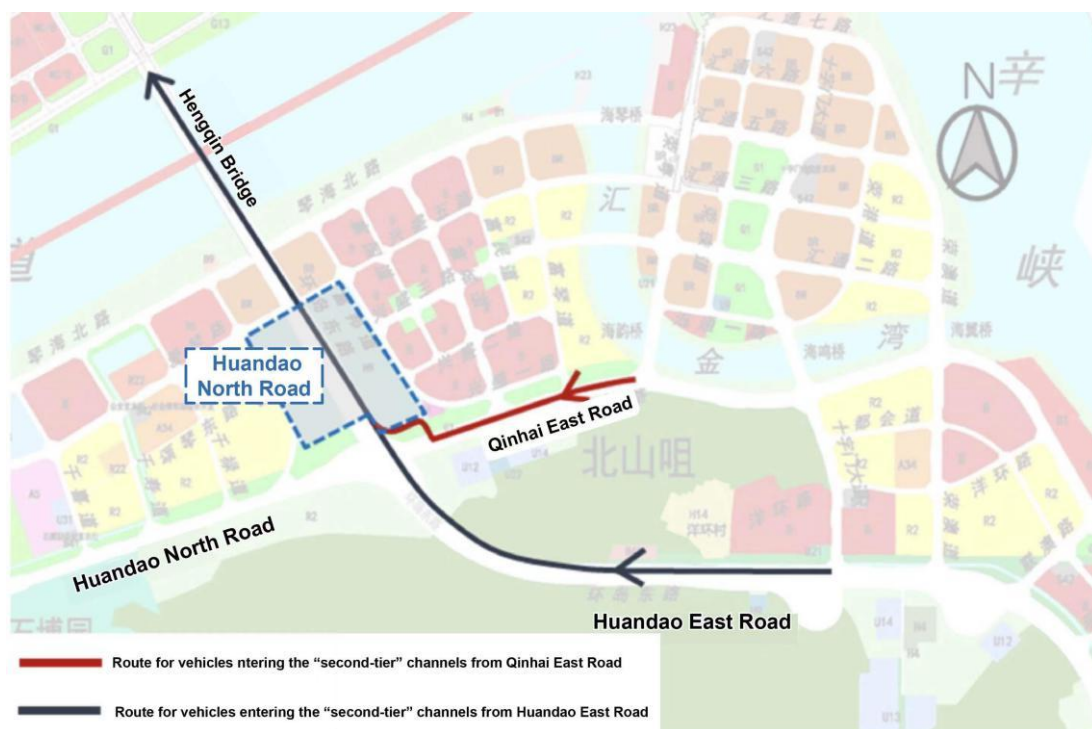


Figure 2. Traffic routes for small passenger vehicles

(2) Medium and Large Passenger Vehicles

Medium and large passenger vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Qinhai East Road. Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave Hengqin island directly, while selected vehicles shall drop off the passengers and undergo customs inspection in the vehicle inspection area before picking up the passengers again. Passengers of the selected vehicles shall walk through the departure hall with their belongings and get on the vehicles again to leave the island.

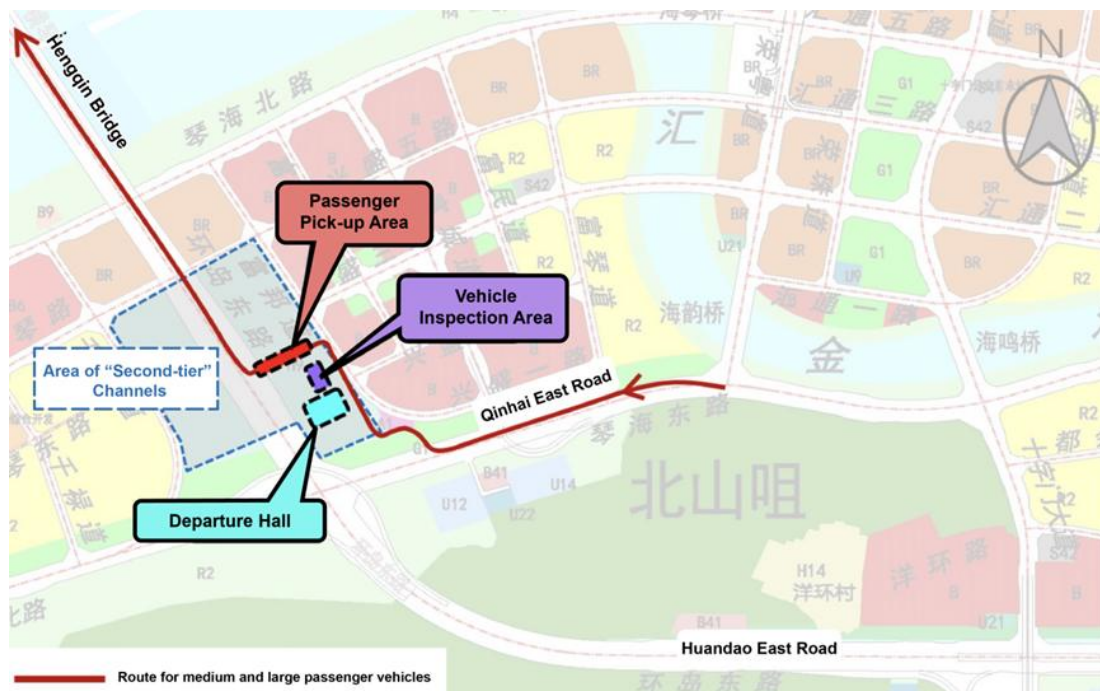


Figure 3. Traffic route for medium and large passenger vehicles

(3) Regular buses

Buses entering the “second-line” from Qinhai East Road shall drop off the passengers at the “Hengqin Bridge Second-line Channel South” stop (provisional name). Passengers shall walk through the departure hall with their belongings to the “Hengqin Bridge Second-tier Channel North” stop where they can take the bus again to leave Hengqin island.

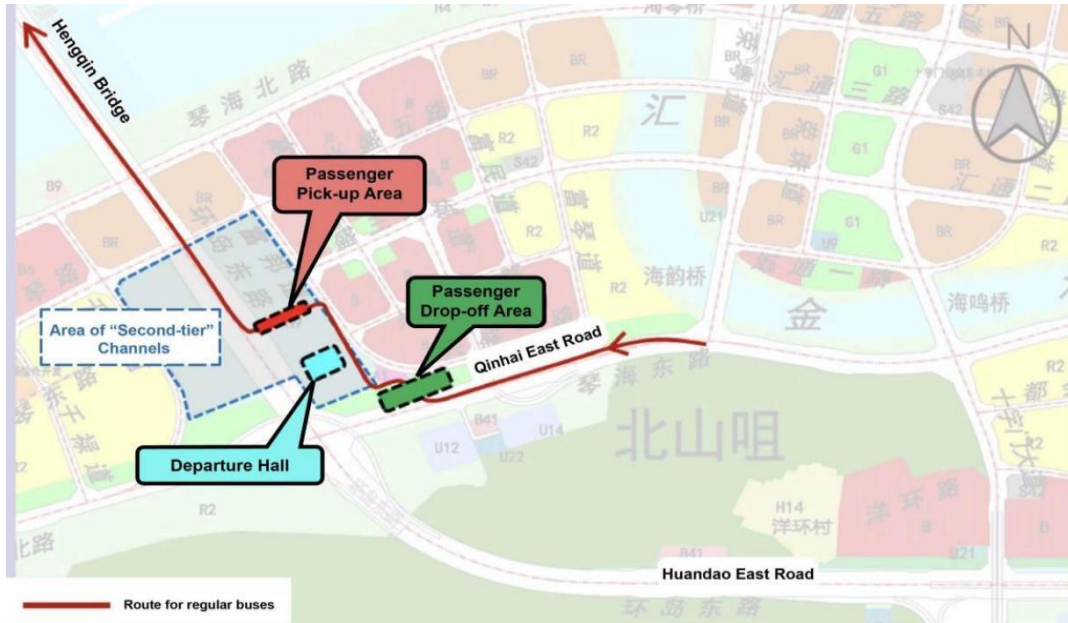


Figure 4. Traffic route for regular buses leaving Hengqin island via the Hengqin Bridge

(4) Taxis and online ride-hailing vehicles

Taxis and online ride-hailing vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Qinhai East Road. Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave Hengqin island directly, while selected vehicles shall go to the vehicle inspection area as instructed and undergo customs inspection before leaving the island.

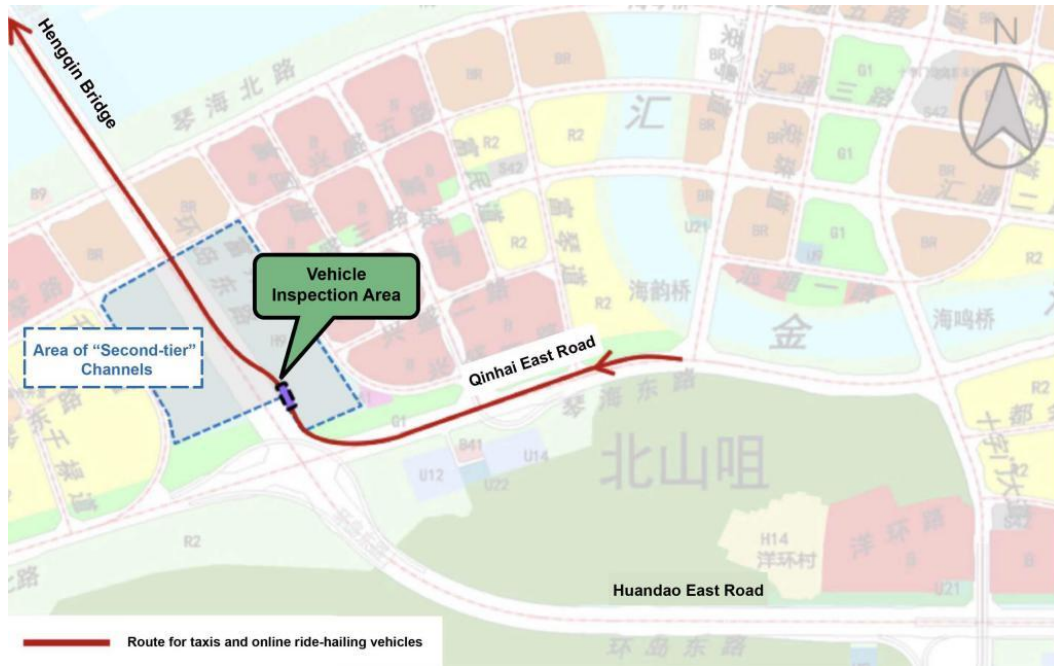
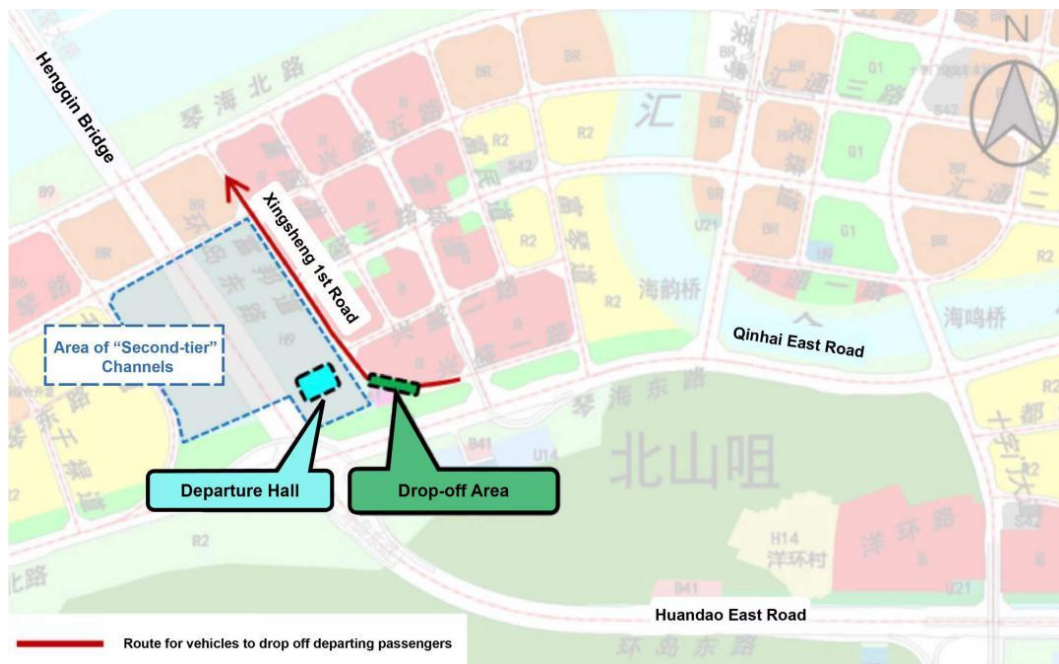


Figure 5. Traffic route for taxis and online ride-hailing vehicles

(5) Vehicles to drop off departing passengers



Vehicles shall drop off the passengers in the drop-off area on Xingsheng 1st Road, and passengers shall walk through the departure hall with their belongings to leave Hengqin island.

(6) Pedestrians and bicycles

Pedestrians and bicycles shall pass through the departure hall to leave Hengqin island.

2. The Hengqin Tunnel

Freight vehicles (including construction vehicles) and small passenger vehicles can leave Hengqin island through the Hengqin Tunnel.

Opening hours: all day

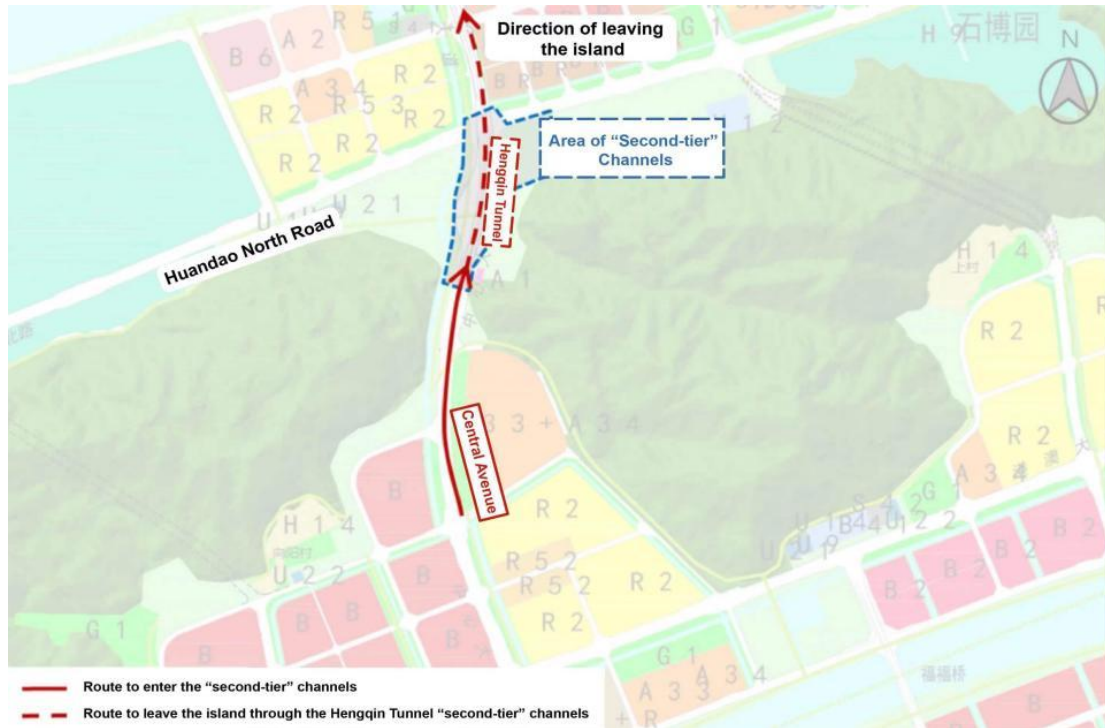
Vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Central Avenue before leaving the island.

(1) Freight vehicles (including construction vehicles)

Vehicles with goods to declare shall go to the vehicle inspection area as instructed and go through relevant customs formalities before leaving the island.

Vehicles with nothing to declare that are not selected for customs inspection can leave the island directly, while those selected for inspection shall go to the vehicle inspection area as instructed and undergo customs inspection before leaving the island.

(2) Small passenger vehicles



Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave the island directly, while selected vehicles shall go to the vehicle inspection area as instructed and undergo customs inspection before leaving the island.

3. The Shenjing Passage

Only tour coaches and registered passenger vehicles can leave the island through the Shenjing Passage.

Opening hours: 06:00–24:00

(1) Tour coaches and registered medium and large passenger vehicles

Vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Huandao West Road as instructed.

Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave the island directly, while selected vehicles shall drop off the passengers and undergo customs inspection in the vehicle inspection area before picking up the passengers again. Passengers of

the selected vehicles shall walk through the departure hall with their belongings and get on the vehicles again to leave the island.

(2) Registered small passenger vehicles

Vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Huandao West Road as instructed. Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave the island directly, while selected vehicles shall undergo customs inspection in the vehicle inspection area before leaving the island.

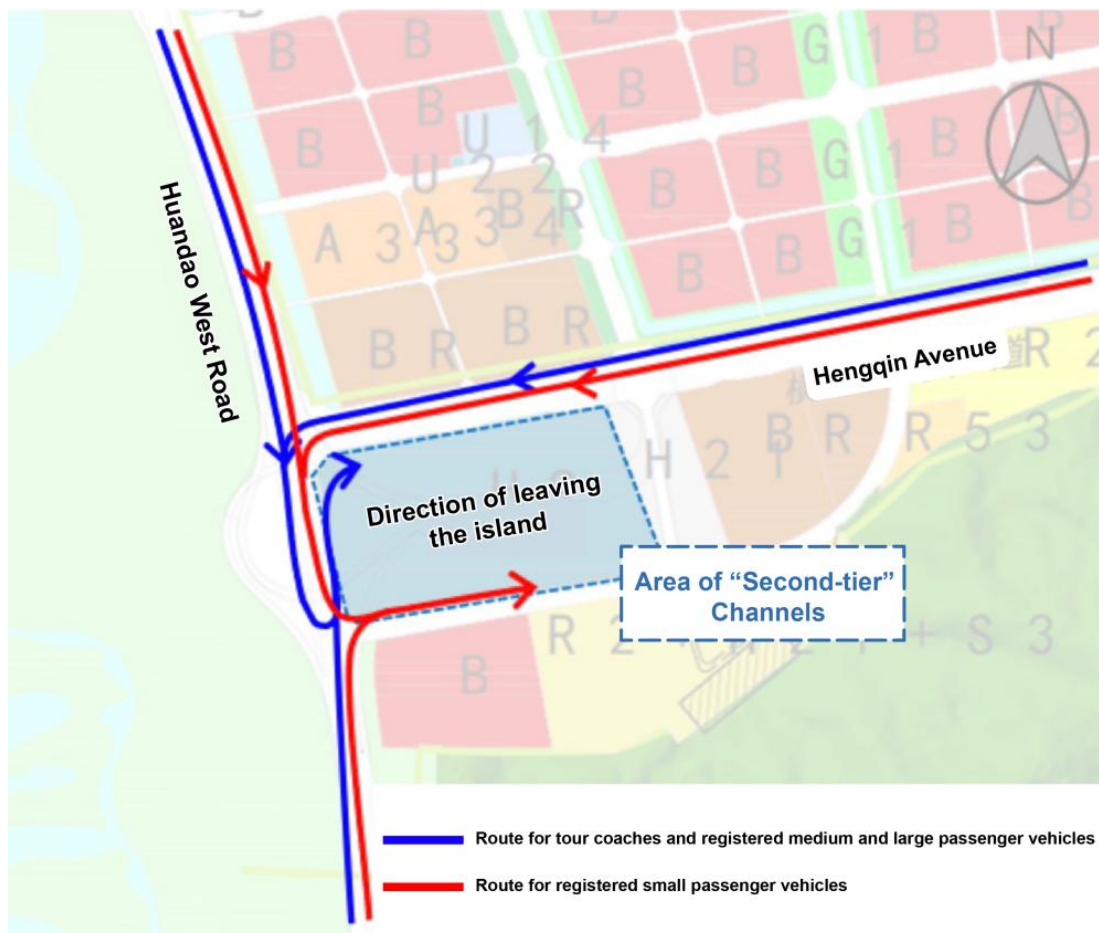


Figure 8. Traffic routes for vehicles leaving Hengqin island through the Shenjing Passage

4. The Shizimen Tunnel

Only registered small passenger vehicles can leave Hengqin island through the Shizimen Tunnel.

Opening hours: 08:00–24:00

Vehicles shall enter the “second-line” from Rongyue Road. Vehicles that are not selected for customs inspection can leave the island directly, while selected vehicles go to the vehicle inspection area as instructed for customs inspection in before leaving the island.

5. The Hengqin Wharf

The opening hours are subject to the actual sailing schedule of the wharf.

Passengers shall pass through the customs inspection hall in the wharf before getting on board to leave the island as instructed.

6. Hengqin Railway Station and Zhuhaichanglong Railway Station

The opening hours are subject to the actual train schedules of the railway stations.

Passengers shall pass through the customs inspection hall in the railway stations before getting on board to leave Hengqin island as instructed.

7. Other Measures

Vehicles carrying out emergency rescue tasks shall be given priority to pass through all the channels in the corresponding opening hours. The passage of other special vehicles shall be subject to the requirements of relevant authorities in charge of the corresponding sectors.

8. This notice shall take effect from the date of the start of the special customs operation in the Guangdong-Macao In-Depth Cooperation Zone in Hengqin.
